The Repository is an online open-access resource set up by CEELBAS (The Centre for East European Language Based Area Studies) to support language training for research on Central \& Eastern Europe and Russia, focusing on the humanities and social sciences.


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The CEELBAS Language Repository

This open-access Language Repository has been developed as a major innovative national and international resource to support language training for social sciences and humanities research on Central and Eastern Europe and Russia

The Repository has the twin objectives of advancing the availability of specially designed teaching and self-study materials and promoting pedagogic reflection on language learning. It contains materials developed at universities across the CEELBAS network, as well as presentations and seminar and project reports on languagerelated research. These materials are accessible to interested users for the longer term through the Repository

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CEELBAS is one of five inter-university centres established in 2006 as part of the UK Funding Councils' Language-Based Area Studies Initiative. The strong focus on language provision reflects the government's strategic commitment to redressing deficits in language training in UK higher education and is based on the premise that researchers and specialists of a particular region cannot operate effectively in their sphere without a high degree of language competence.

The CEELBAS Language Repository hosts a wide range of language teaching materials (for Bulgarian, Croatian, Czech, Estonian, Finnish, Hungarian, Polish, Romanian, Russian, Serbian, Slovak and Ukrainian). It also reflects other types of language activity undertaken by teachers and researchers from CEELBAS partner institutions, including articles, presentations,
seminars, workshop and conference materials, online resources supporting course design and fieldwork guides.

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CEELBAS is a consortium of leading UK universities, launched in 2006 as part of the UK Funding Councils' Language-Based Area Studies Initiative: Bath, Birmingham, Cambridge, Kent, Manchester, Oxford, Sheffield, SOAS, UCL, Warwick

Repository resources include authentic materials in a wide range of formats: audio, video, podcasts, slideshows, links to websites, readers and materials supporting the acquisition of grammar and vocabulary.
